Perceived neighborhood social support (1–5 on a Likert scale)	0.858
<p>If I need it, I can rely on neighbors to help me with small household tasks (e.g., groceries, looking after my kids, ...).</p> <p>If I need it, I can rely on neighbors to bring me to the doctor.</p> <p>If I need it, I can rely on neighbors to help me with small repairs.</p>	
Neighborhood sense of community (1–5 on a Likert scale)	0.833

Shared interests (1–5 on a Likert scale)**0.823**

Supportive communication (1–5 on a Likert scale)**0.843**

I react (with expressions or comments) on ONN messages with positive neighborhood news.

I react supportively to bad neighborhood news on the ONN.

I help others out when they ask a question on the ONN.

I advise others on the ONN.

Informational support mobilization (1–5 on a Likert scale)**0.829**

When I would need a good bakery, bike repair, or similar commercial services in the neighborhood, I would use the ONN to look for more information.

When I would need to know about the opening hours of a store or public service, I would use the ONN to look for more information.

When I hear a strange noise or encounter a strange event (accident, street closed, ...), I would use the ONN to look for more information.

When I encounter an unclear traffic condition, I would use the ONN to look for more information.

Tangible support mobilization (1–5 on a Likert scale)**0.826**

When I would need physical help (e.g., lifting something heavy), I would use the ONN.
