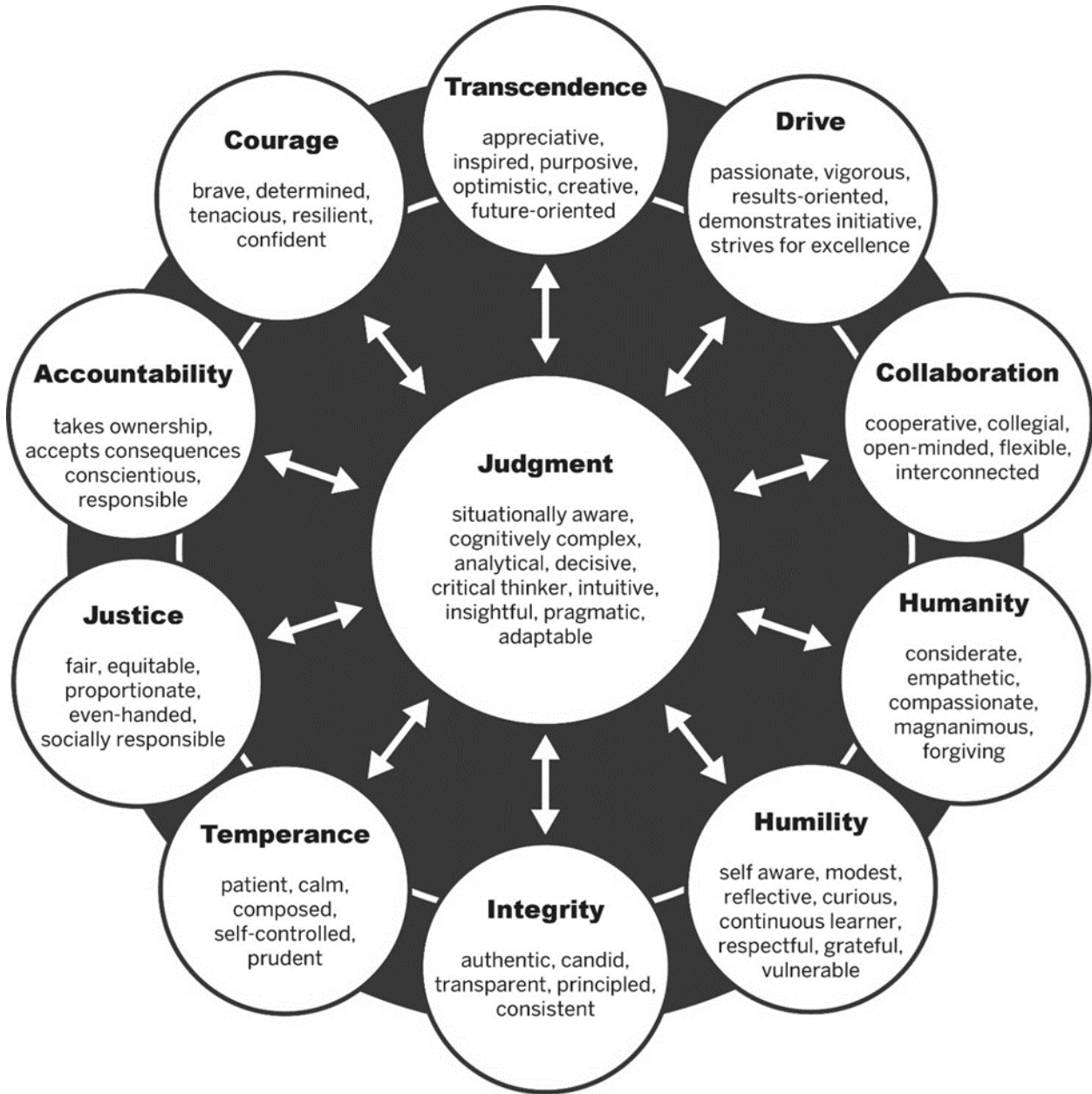

41 *Framework of Leader Character adapted from Crossan et al. (2017).*

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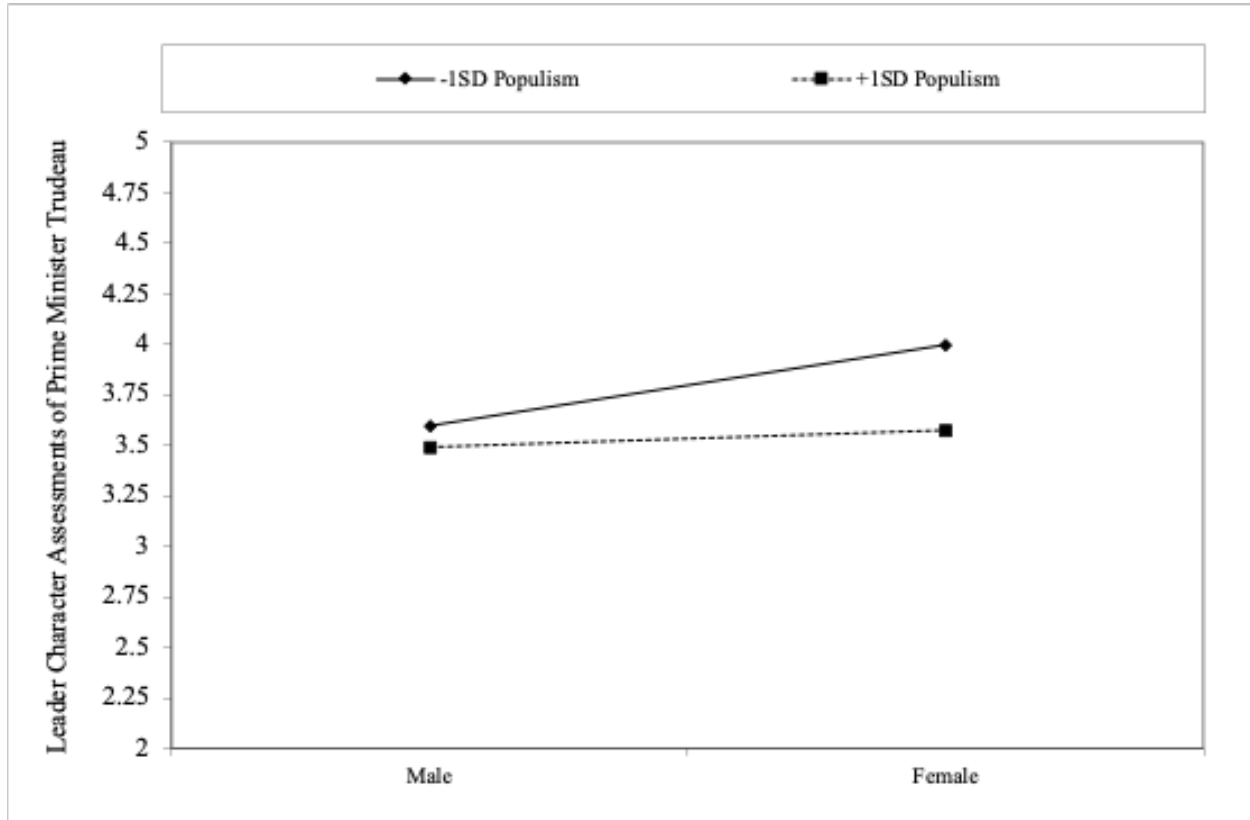
