Ableist structures at the university	Structures in general	Descriptions of HS as an ableist/ableist reproducing system in general	"so the structure of the university is already blocking it."
	Unrecognized skills	Skills that tend to produce exclusion or are not recognized	"that such an open expression of uncertainty, of doubt, of not knowing or of incompetence is actually always associated with devaluation or even exclusion."

	Barriers due to the term	Barriers created by the term (Foreign word/ incomprehensibility, unfamiliarity of the term)	"i also think that for many people this is more of a foreign word"
	Missing points of contact	Lack of dissemination/thematization in everyday life/society/...	"but in discussions with other teaching disciplines or other students, such topics are not discussed at all."
Ways to reduce ableism	Own action	Options for action at an individual level	"to also engage in this permanent reflection, what am I asking for, what am I doing right now, how does it reproduce what?"
	'External' factors	External changes (social/structural/institutional/...)	"but it is equally important that it is included in teaching at all."
